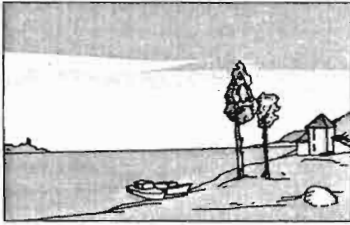


Mardi Gras was a Success!

Homeowners at L.B.C.C.!

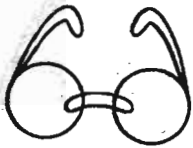

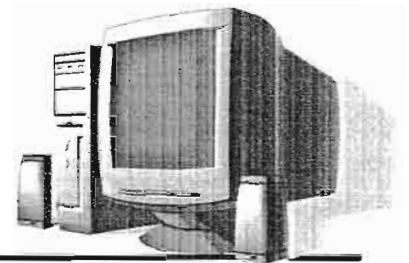
Lake Bracken Online Gets an Update

WE ARE ASKING FOR YOUR COOPERATION. WE HAVE SEVERAL AREAS THAT ARE STARTING TO SHOW LOTS OF WEAR FROM CART PATH TRAFFIC. WE WOULD LIKE TO AVOID PUTTING UP ROPES AND STAKES OR PAINTING ORANGE LINES. THE ROPES ARE HIGH MAINTENANCE PROBLEMS. WE REQUEST THAT YOU AVOID DRIVING IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS.

- AVOID THE BARE AREA TO THE BACK OF THE TURNAROUND ON 5 TEE.
- DON'T DRIVE BETWEEN # 5 GREEN AND # 4 TEE.
- DON'T DRIVE TO THE LEFT OF # 6 GREEN. USE THE PATH ON THE RIGHT.
- DON'T DRIVE BEYOND THE BURMS ON # 8 GREEN.
- DON'T DRIVE ON THE RIGHT OF # 9 GREEN BETWEEN THE GREEN AND ROAD.
- DON'T DRIVE IN FRONT OF # 12 TEE AND DON'T DRIVE DOWN TO # 11 GREEN.
- DON'T DRIVE BETWEEN # 12 GREEN AND THE PATH. IF YOU MUST GO TO THE RIGHT SIDE, STAY HIGH AND AVOID THE WORN BARE AREAS.
- DON'T DRIVE BETWEEN THE END OF THE BUNKER AND # 13 GREEN.
- STAY ON THE PATH TO THE LEFT OF # 14 GREEN.
- DON'T DRIVE OVER THE BURM LEFT OF # 17 GREEN TO GET TO # 18 TEE.

Bass Tournament

Lake Bracken Fire Dept.

Date: Sunday September 7th

7:00 A.M. till 1:00 P.M.

Kick off from Beach or old clubhouse area. Be at the Beach by 6:15 to pay entry fee and have pre-tournament meeting.

Shotgun start – all boats no-wake speed only for the tournament.

Two persons per team

No pre-fishing for three days prior to the tournament.

There will be no open pre-fishing for non Lake Bracken members.

All boats must have aerated live wells. No stringers or fish baskets.

All boats must have liability insurance. Artificial lures only.

The limit will be: Six 12” bass per team. A dead fish penalty of 1 pound per dead fish will be assessed. Short fish (closed mouth pinched tail) 2pound penalty plus loss of fish.

Entry Fee: \$ 60.00 Dollars per boat. Ten Dollars of that is for the big bass pot. (Cash only- no checks can be accepted)

Pay back will be 80% of the remaining \$ 50.00 fee. In other words \$ 10.00 per boat goes to the Lake Bracken Fire Dept.

First place 50%

Second place 30%

Third place 20%

Since parking at the ramp is very limited. We will have to launch boats and drive trailers around to park across from swimming pool and walk down to meet your boat.

After the tournament we may eat at the clubhouse. However the golfers have priority for parking. We might have to drop trailers back at the pool to have enough room to park.
