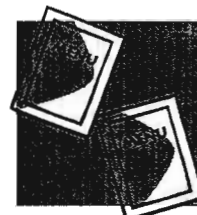

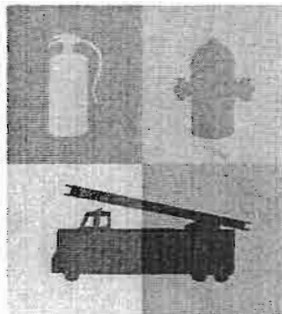
The Heat is on!!!!!!!!!!

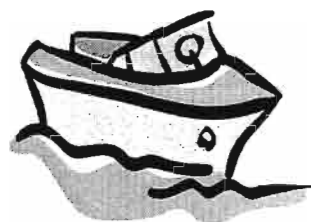


Fireworks will be at dusk-between 9:00 and 9:30 P.M. on July 4th

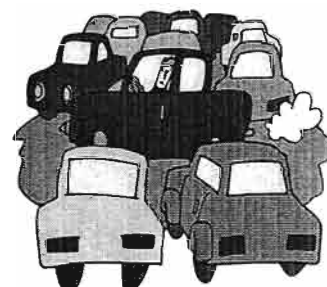

### PARKING AT THE POOL

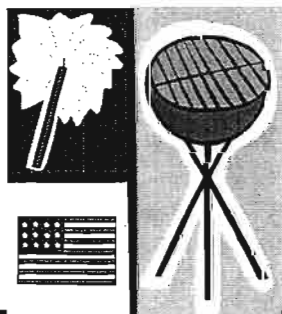
