

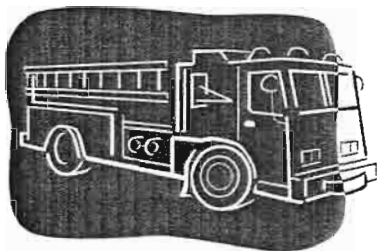

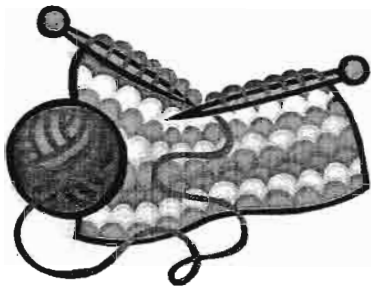

Bass Tournament Lake Bracken Fire Dept.



Date: Sunday--- Oct 4

7:00A.M till 1:00 P.M.

Kick off from Beach or old clubhouse area. Be at the Beach by 6:30 A.M. to pay entry fee and have pre-tournament meeting.

Shotgun start – all boats no-wake speed only for the tournament.

Two persons per team—(no alcohol during tournament)

No pre-fishing for three days prior to the tournament.

There will be no open pre-fishing for non Lake Bracken members.

All boats must have aerated live wells. No stringers or fish baskets.

All boats must have liability insurance. Artificial lures only.

The limit will be: Six 12” bass per team. A dead fish penalty of 1 pound per dead fish will be assessed. Short fish (closed mouth pinched tail) 2 pound penalty plus loss of fish.

Entry Fee: \$ 60.00 Dollars per boat. Ten Dollars of that is for the big bass pot. (Cash only- no checks can be accepted)

Pay back will be 80% of the remaining \$ 50.00 fee. In other words \$ 10.00 per boat goes to the Lake Bracken Fire Dept.

Third place 20%

Since parking at the ramp is very limited. We will have to launch boats and drive trailers around to park across from swimming pool and walk down to meet your boat.
