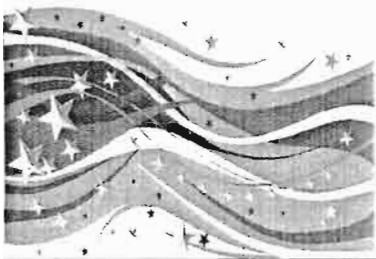

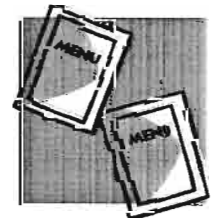

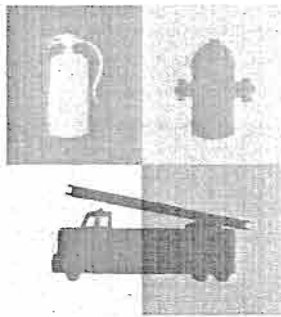


The Heat is on!!!!!!!!!!

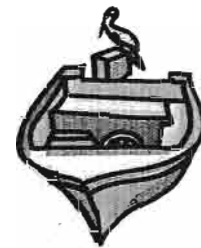

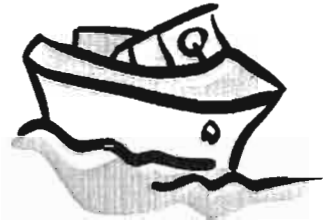


Fireworks will be at dusk-between 9:00 and 9:30 P.M. on July 3rd

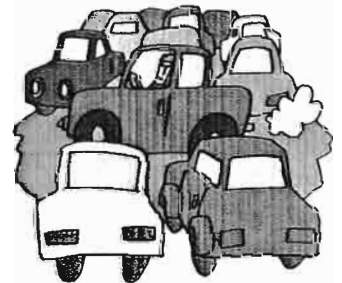

PARKING AT THE POOL

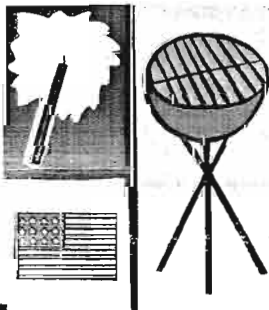

A word from the coaches....

The Blue Wave's are off to their best start since 1998!

We have become one of the hottest, most competitive Country Club swimming programs in Central Illinois.

We opened our season in Peoria swimming in the Annual IVY Relay meet. This is the formal kick off for competitive swimming in Peoria and we are the 1st team ever outside of Peoria invited to this meet.

The Blue Waves won the meet scoring 68 points and winning 11 events!

We swam a dual meet against Soangetaha CC. Tuesday, June 15 ending up with another victory with a score of 477 to 213.

Then it was the 18th Annual Lake Bracken Relay meet Saturday, June 19th. It was the Blue Waves day to shine! Lake Bracken won every single event! The last time any team won every event at this meet was 1998 and guess who that was. The Blue Waves scored 154 points to Lakeside's 108 and Soangetaha's 82 points.

We are well on our way to having two back to back undefeated seasons!!!

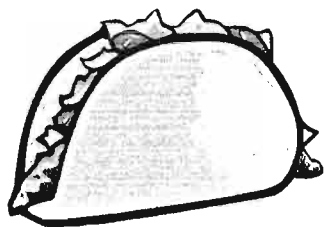

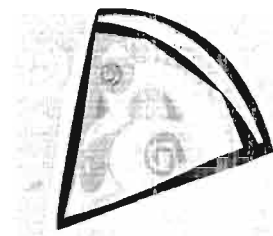

S. O. S.

Save our Shoreline

Please slow to a fast idle (1500 RPM) within 75 feet of a shoreline or in posted “NO WAKE” zones in narrow coves and near the island.

Our shoreline is rapidly being undercut by wakes from boats going too fast. (A “wake” is any wave pattern put into the water off the back of the boat.) Waves erode shorelines, undermine trees and damage docks and tied boats. Notice the bare roots showing under many trees around the island. All of that missing soil is now silt filling the lake. Next year, those trees will probably be in the lake too. Dead trees decaying the lake deplete oxygen that is vital to fish. Fallen trees are very difficult and expensive to remove.

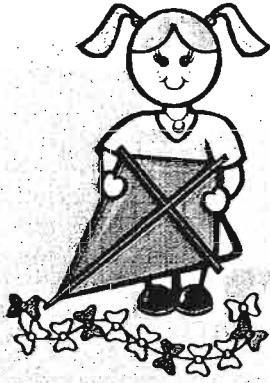
