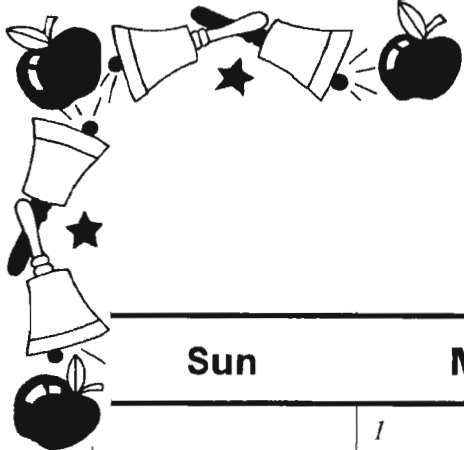
## *Rally For A Cure*

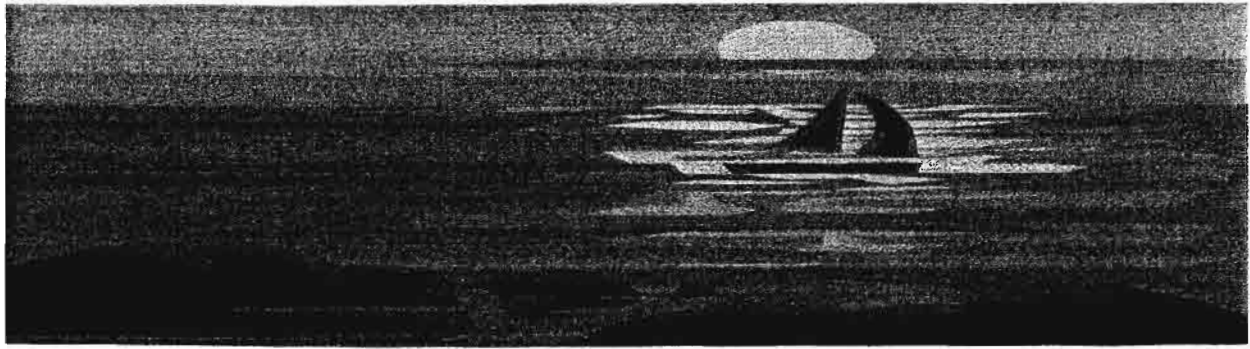

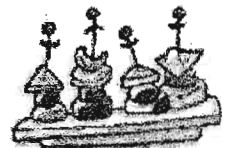
